# FACULTY CRITICAL INCIDENT RESPONSE TRAINING

Keeping your school violence free gets tougher every day. But a comprehensive approach ~ one that addresses the full spectrum of violence from scuffles to shootings ~ can vastly simplify the job.

**Only the INPAX® approach addresses each of the major aspects of school violence:**

## 1. Student-on-teacher violence

We train your faculty to plan for, prevent and respond to the assaults from students that have grown more common in recent years in suburban and urban schools alike. Teachers will learn, moreover, how to respond to violence in ways that minimize injury to themselves and the student and bring the incident to a swift resolution.

- Our full spectrum training includes: recognizing potentially violent students; deterring and defusing situations verbally and non-verbally; how to respond to a physical attack with self-protective measures that disengage the teacher quickly from the conflict without causing injury to the offending student.

## 2. Fight interdiction

Teachers learn how – whether acting independently or as members of an ad hoc team – to intercede in a fight safely and effectively. The techniques taught offer a range of simple methods, involving minimal need for size or physical strength, to restore control and reduce injury to students and faculty alike.

## 3. Critical incident response

We provide teachers with the means to respond to armed aggression – whether by a student, a terrorist or simply a deranged individual – should preventive measures fail. Our training isn't aimed at turning teachers into security personnel – but rather to equip them with tools that can reduce panic and offer last-resort options when running and hiding are no longer viable alternatives.

- Since the shooting at Virginia Tech, most schools and universities are intensively reviewing, and rethinking lock-down drills and emergency response protocols for an active shooter situation. Yet few equip their teachers with training on how to cope with a worst-case scenario: an active school shooter. INPAX critical incident response training is the first of its kind in the U.S. to address this potentially fatal gap in response planning.

## Course Design

### Interactive training

INPAX® Critical Incident Response Training takes place in an interactive workshop format where participants can learn, hands-on, the physical skills and strategies needed to manage violent situations. The emphasis of the course, however, is on prevention through active preparation – identifying the sources of school violence and on methods for anticipating and preventing it. The skills taught in this comprehensive program are systematically related, allowing teachers to use same basic techniques in a wide variety of circumstances from a shoving match to a full-on armed attack. This unique approach permits a substantial “vocabulary” of control techniques to be presented and mastered in a short time frame.

All of the physical skills and strategies taught have been carefully selected to maximize effectiveness while minimizing risk of injury.

## Program Developer & Head Instructor

Sam Rosenberg – professional bodyguard and an industry leader in the management of interpersonal human aggression, developed the Faculty Critical Incident Training program to address a potentially fatal gap in the protective continuum surrounding our teachers and the students entrusted to their care. As a former Marine Corps officer, bodyguard and executive security consultant to Fortune 500 companies, as well as a US Marine officer, Mr. Rosenberg recognizes that, to be effective, security measures must be part of a continuum. In Mr. Rosenberg's words, “while it's good to have a lifeguard, it's better to know how to swim™”.
